In this release, the following new features have been rolled out to CalUsource:



- Response Workbench Scores based on Finalized Score Card
- Response Workbench Audit Log Enhancement

Sourcing Enhancements

Mark a Question as Acceptable/Unacceptable

Apart from providing score, a buyer can now mark a question as **Acceptable** or **Unacceptable** in the evaluation type. A drop-down is made available against each question with the value as **Score**, **Informative**, and **Acceptable/Unacceptable**. Thus, while evaluating instead of providing score, the buyer can provide the evaluation for the question as **Acceptable** or **Unacceptable** with comments.



Drop Down Descriptions

Score: an evaluator will score this question between 0-4

Informative: no score or weight will be associated with this questions. This is purely an FYI


Acceptable or Unacceptable: an evaluator is only given 2 options when reviewing. The answer is either acceptable or not. No weight will be associated to this question.

Response Workbench - Scores based on Finalized Score Card

Response Workbench now displays scores and weight based on the Finalized Score Card. In case the score card is not finalized, the scores will be based on the default score card.

Response Workbench - Audit Log Enhancement

The audit log will now capture the details of user viewing response workbench. If any user clicks Response Workbench to view Supplier responses, an entry will be made in the response workbench audit log indicating the type of action performed



Action Performed Status

Response Summary: A user has accessed the response work bench to start reviewing supplier responses.

Score Submitted: The Users have gone in a submitted a score for a particular supplier
